Mission

Oregon Ag Fest is a nonprofit 501 (c)(3) volunteer organization dedicated to educating the public about the importance of agriculture.

Purpose

To reward student organizations, non-profit organizations, or classrooms that promote and educate Oregonians about agriculture and extend the Oregon Ag Fest mission beyond its annual, 2-day, interactive event.

Awards

Cash prizes totaling up to \$2,000 may be awarded to as many as three winners annually. Awards will be presented on stage during Oregon Ag Fest on April 26. Award prizes will depend on quality of applications submitted.

Award Criteria

- Must be a student organization, non-profit organization, or classroom, that is applying, not an individual
- Applicant must be located in Oregon
- To be considered, the project must have occurred during the 2018 or 2019 calendar year
- Projects taking place as part of Oregon Ag Fest are not eligible for submission
- Award recipients are required to be present on April 28 at Ag Fest to receive their award
- Applicants are only eligible to receive one award per year
- The project must educate the public about agriculture
- All entries received and any materials submitted as part of the application become the property of Oregon Ag Fest and will not be returned
